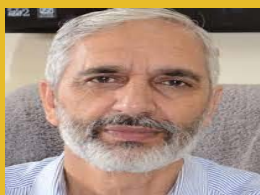

Government Degree College, Sopore Kashmir arose out of humble origin as an intermediate college in 1949, then housed in present Boys Higher Secondary Institute Sopore with Late Prof. Mufti Jalal-ud-din as its first Principal. The foundation stone of the college was formally laid down by the Prime Minister Hon'ble Late Sheikh Muhammad Abdullah on 27th of September, 1951 starting with a meager roll of 50 odd students in 1951.
