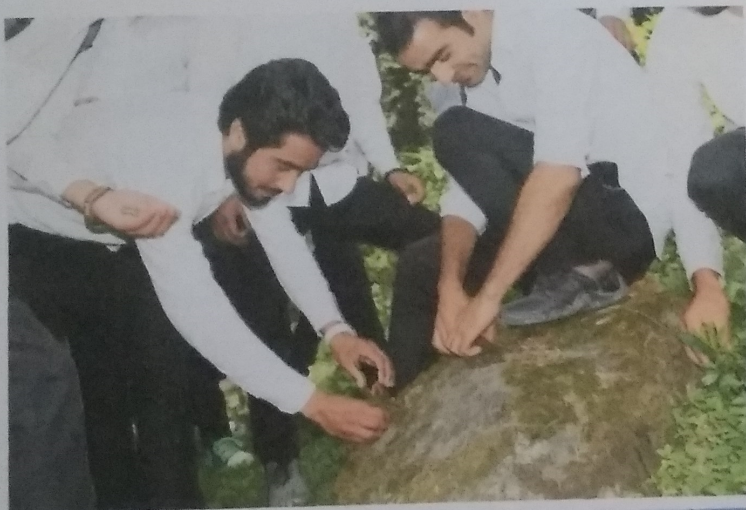



## Workshop on conservation of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants.
