1. One Day Awareness Programme on Gender Equity: Emerging Issues and Challenges organised by Women Development Cell in collaboration with IQAC conducted on 15.04.2019 at Auditorium Hall under the Chairmanship of Prof. Farooq Ahmad Malik worthy Principal was conducted.
2. Prof. Farooq Ahmad Malik highlighted the relevance to develop and use cross sectional monitoring and evaluation tools to understand the gender effects of non-education and/or life skills focused programming on educational outcomes and the effects of education programming on gender-based violence, sexual and reproductive health and economic empowerment outcomes.
3. Also conducting of long-term, longitudinal studies to capture the lifelong effects of gender transformative and educational programming on participants' adult employment, health and other gender equality related outcomes.
4. Ensuring that all education sector programming disaggregates results by gender, regardless of the focus of the program. Where safe for students to self-identify as such, allow non-binary gender identification response options for students
5. Dr. Nusrat Aziz highlighted that further complicating the picture of gender in global education, there is limited evidence on the efficacy of gender-focused education programs that target both girls and boys, the gendered effects of gender-neutral education programming and the effects of life-skills and non-academic programming on academic outcomes, particularly in low- and middle- income country context.

Prof. Tariq Ahmad Wani showcased how the gender equity is being bridged by the institutional interventions in the state of J&K and how women have evolved as strong contenders in politics, academics and administration. Prof. Tariq Wani in his concluding note thanked all the dignitaries for participating in the event and delivered vote of thanks.
