More than 3 lac applications were received for a 4th class post in the UT of J&K and even PhD holders applied for such positions which do not commensurate with their educational qualifications. Degree College Sopore is taking a lead by introducing vocational programmes through community college Scheme that will help and serve the people of Sopore area.
