MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

On this 1st day of June 2022

Between

Department of Islamic Studies, Government Degree College Sopore Jammu & Kashmir

and

Department of Islamic History M.E.S Mampad College (Autonomous), Kerala

The general objective of this memorandum of understanding is to stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs that serve to enhance the intellectual life and cultural development of both institutions. The Department of Islamic Studies, Govt. Degree College, Sopore, and Department of Islamic History, MES Mampad College (Autonomous) has agreed in support of their mutual interests in the field of education and research.

- 1. The two educational institutions will:
- a) Co-operate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in mutual interests.
- b) Promote appropriate joint research projects.
- c) Conduct cultural projects mutually agreed in writing between the parties before the commencement of this activity.
- d) To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate there in.
- e) Facility and student exchange programs in the field of mutual interests.
- 2. The MoU shall aim to achieve a broad balance in the respective contribution and benefits of the collaboration and this shall be subject to periodic review by both institutions.
- 3. The host institution agrees to assist in the seeking of appropriate housing and to supply a workspace, library, and technical facilities as appropriate.
- 4. In the implementation of specific cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the applications to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed upon, and formalized in writing, before the commencement of the project.
- 5. Establish a mutually beneficial partnership between colleges that show a flexible and creative response to the organizational, missions, and fiscal needs of both institutions.
- 6. Shared use of facilities including classrooms, office, and library facilities that reduce operating costs and promotes collaboration of students, security, staff, and community members in program.

Reporting requirements and time frame

This MoU will commence on 01/06/2022 for 5 years. This MoU is the complete agreement between the Department of Islamic Studies, **Govt. Degree College, Sopore, and Department of Islamic History MES Mampad College,** and may be amended only by written agreement signed by age of the parties involved.
