Dear Chief Secretary,

D.O. No. PA/383/2023-Deputy Secretary

As you are aware, the Government of India, with participation of States and Union Territories, is actively engaged in a mission to link every possible beneficiary with the benefit of its flagship schemes for providing basic amenities like sanitation facilities, essential financial services, access to LPG connections, housing for the poor, food security, proper nutrition, reliable healthcare, clean drinking water, quality education etc. and making required services accessible to all targeted and eligible beneficiaries.

- 2. With this aim, a nationwide campaign to raise awareness through outreach activities to achieve saturation of schemes named "Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra". The Yatra will be launched on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 on the occasion of *Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas*, which will be initially visiting districts having significant Scheduled Tribe population and the remaining districts from 3<sup>rd</sup> week of November, 2023 upto 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2023. The vehicle would go to all the Gram Panchayats, covering 2 3 Gram Panchayats on one day. In States/Constituencies having elections, the Yatra will be scheduled after the Model Code of Conduct is lifted. The objectives of the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra are as follows:
  - (i) Reaching the unreached reach out to the vulnerable who are eligible under various schemes but have not availed benefit so far.
  - (ii) Dissemination of information and generating awareness about schemes.
  - (iii) Learning from the citizens Interaction with beneficiaries of Government Schemes through personal stories / experience sharing.
  - (iv) Enrolment of potential beneficiaries through details ascertained during the Yatra.
- 3. In this regard, the flagship Scheme of Poshan Abhiyan under Mission Poshan 2.0 is part of the enlisted schemes. In view of the same, the roles and responsibilities of State/District/Block/AWW level functionaries for Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra has been delineated as 'Activities before the Event' and 'Activities during the Event'. The detailed role-wise responsibilities are as follows:

#### A. Pre -event responsibilities

- I. State WCD/ Social Welfare Department :
  - (a) To issue circular to the districts articulating roles, responsibilities and actions to be taken by the respective officers at Gram Panchayat level.

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- (b) Conducting Training / Orientation for all Staff responsible for the event in convergence with other participating Departments.
- (c) Organizing VCs with field functionaries to sensitize them about Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra.

#### II. District level:

- (a) Ensure the Online Portal Registration for the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra.
- (b) Identification and nomination of Block Level Officers and Poshan Block Co-ordinators to coordinate the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra in each Gram Panchayat under respective Blocks.
- (c) To supervise, monitor and coordinate with Block Level Officer /Gram Panchayats.

## III. Block Level Officer/Block Co-ordinator/ Lady Supervisor:

- (a) Preparation of the script for Meri Kahani Meri Zubani (experience of benefits of the scheme by beneficiaries of Anganwadi Service) and ensure its readiness by the beneficiary.
- (b) Identification of 5 beneficiaries from each Gram Panchayat for Meri Kahani Meri Zubani for narration of their experience of benefits of the scheme.
- (c) Entering the data on number of invitees on the application being developed for this purpose.

#### IV. AWWs

- (a) To inform and invite the beneficiaries during the Community Based Event conducted in AWC before the event, or when the beneficiary come to AWC to collect THR or during Home Visits.
- (b) To remind beneficiaries under the Poshan Abhiyan to attend the event, 1 day before the arrival of the vehicle in their designated Gram Panchayat.
- (c) Identification of Healthy Children from each Gram Panchayat, as per the Swastha Balak Spardha Norms (copy enclosed) for felicitation during Yatra.

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### B. During the event

At the time of the event, the Block Co-ordinators, Lady Supervisors, AWW and AWH are expected to be present at the designated venue at the Gram Panchayat. Further, DPOs and State PMU officials are to co-ordinate with Block Level Officers and Lady Supervisors in all the Gram Panchayats of the district as per the schedule of the event.

#### District level

- Coordination with Nodal/Prabhari officers of the event to ensure smooth functioning of Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra in the district.
- Daily follow-up with Block-level Officers during the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra.
- II. Block Level Officer/Block Co-ordinator/Lady Supervisor
  - Expected to be present at the designated venue.
  - Coordination with concerned Nodal officers during the visit of Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra.
  - Organizing the Felicitation of Healthy Child identified by AWW during the Yatra.
  - iv. Entering of data for number of people attended the event in the application.

#### III. AWWs

- Expected to be present at the designated venue.
- ii. On-spot registration of the beneficiaries for Anganwadi Services.
- iii. Awareness creation and mobilization of mothers and adolescent girls under Poshan Abhiyan of Mission Poshan 2.0.
- iv. Dissemination of information related to Poshan Abhiyan.
- 4. In this regard, I would like to request and seek your earnest cooperation in undertaking all necessary tasks required for the successful implementation of the campaign and ensure the widest possible participation. I would also request you to constitute a Committee of senior officers under your guidance to steer the campaign in your State/UTs. You may also advise the District Collectors to lead the campaign at the district level and provide necessary logistic support and to form a coordination committee for the same at the District level.

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### **SWASTH BALAK SPARDHA: INTRODUCTION**

POSHAN Abhiyaan focuses on converting the agenda of improving nutrition into a *Jan Andolan* through Behavioural Change while addressing malnutrition across the nation through components like Convergence, ICT Application, Community Mobilization, Capacity Building, Incentives and Awards, and Innovations. As visualised under POSHAN Abhiyaan, the Community Mobilisation and Behaviour Change Communication (BCC) is needed to take-up sustained efforts requiring multi-pronged approach and bring grass-root synergy and convergence.

#### BACKGROUND

For sustained community involvement, it is imperative that nutrition issues should be highlighted with a positive orientation, emphasising on identification and celebration of a "Healthy Child". In this regard, Hon'ble Prime Minister has also emphasised that instilling a competitive feeling among parents to promote health and nutrition amongst their children would lead to sustained community mobilisation and awareness among general public. With this concept, the MoWCD launched the "Swastha Balak Spardha" for children in the age group of 0 to 5 years.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT**

- To bring focus on the "Swastha Balak- Healthy Child"
- To identify healthy children in age group of 6m-3 years and 3-5 years
- To generate awareness and conduct campaigns for growth measurement of children under
   5 years
- To bring in more focus on healthy children than on children with malnutrition
- To promote Breastfeeding and Complementary feeding practices
- To promote counselling regarding importance of diet diversity and age appropriate feeding
- To promote concept of peer educator (mother-to-mother/ family/ community)
- To generate a spirit of competitiveness for good health and nutrition
