

## **REPORT**

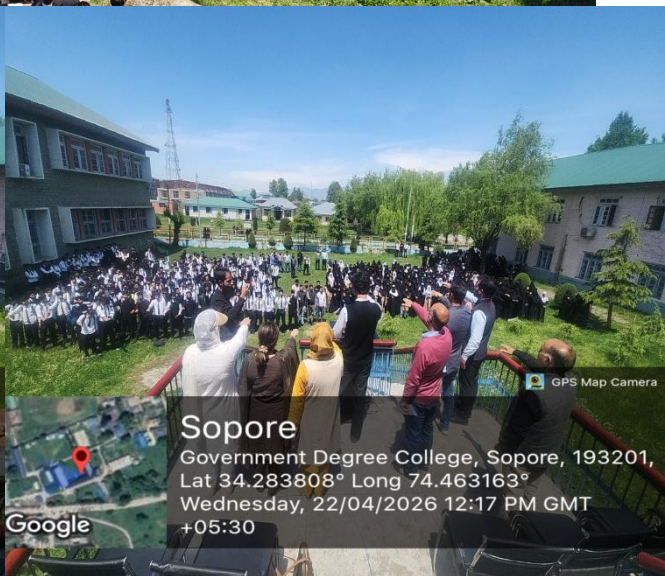

The event commenced with a warm welcome to the students and staff members, by **Dr. Majid Rehman** (Coordinator NMBC), followed by a brief introduction of the objectives of the campaign. Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Majid Rehman presented a comprehensive overview of the campaign. He highlighted the urgent need to address the growing concerns of drug addiction in society and elaborated on the series of activities planned during the 100-day period. These include awareness drives, counselling sessions, workshops, poster-making competitions, seminars, and community outreach programmes designed to educate and engage students as well as the wider community.

The programme was officially inaugurated by **Prof. Zahoor Ahmad Shah** (Principal of the college), who, in his address, emphasized the role of educational institutions in shaping responsible citizens.
